Privacy Policy

This privacy policy was last updated on June 13th, 2024.

Our purposes and legal basis for processing personal data

Third parties

We can engage third parties to which we may disclose or transfer your personal data. In case these third parties process your personal data while performing services for us, we will be responsible for processing your personal data as a controller. For processing your personal data as described in this Privacy Statement, we may disclose your personal data to the following parties: our accountants and advisors; partners of IMPAKTER PRO.

Where applicable, we have agreed upon a data processing agreement with the relevant third party as mentioned above.

We will not disclose or transfer your personal data to third parties for commercial purposes. Only if the law obliges us to do so, we may provide your personal data to regulators and/or (tax) authorities. In all cases, we will take appropriate measures to guarantee the confidentiality and security of your personal data as much as possible.

Security

We have put appropriate (technical) and organizational measures in place to protect the confidentiality and security of information with regard to your personal data. revoke your consent for processing;

an electronic copy of your personal data (data portability);

object to processing your personal data; and

If you wish to exercise any of the rights set out above, please contact us via the contact details stated below. We may ask you to provide proper proof of your identity in order to prevent somebody from pretending to be you and thus getting access to your data.

National supervisory authority
